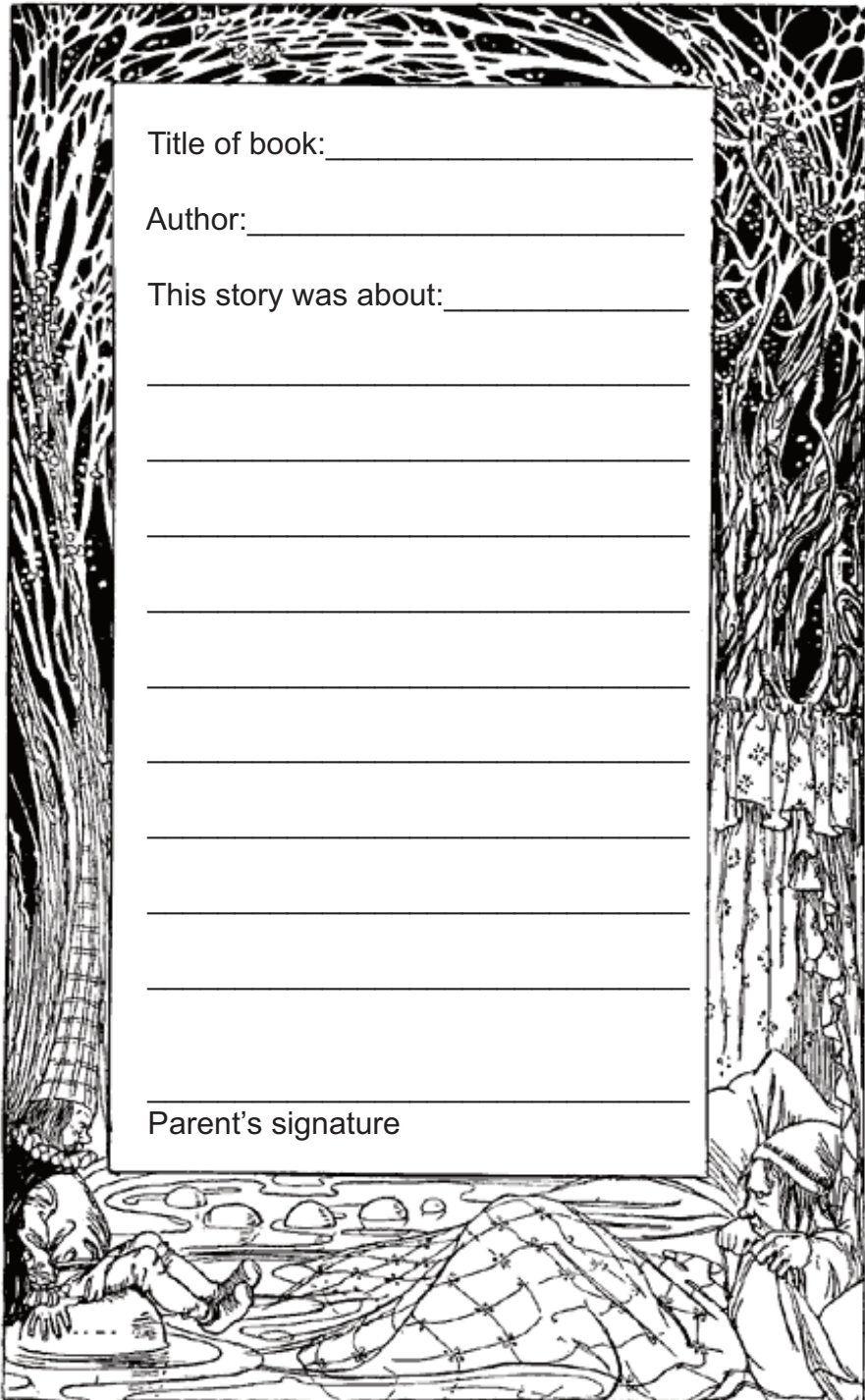

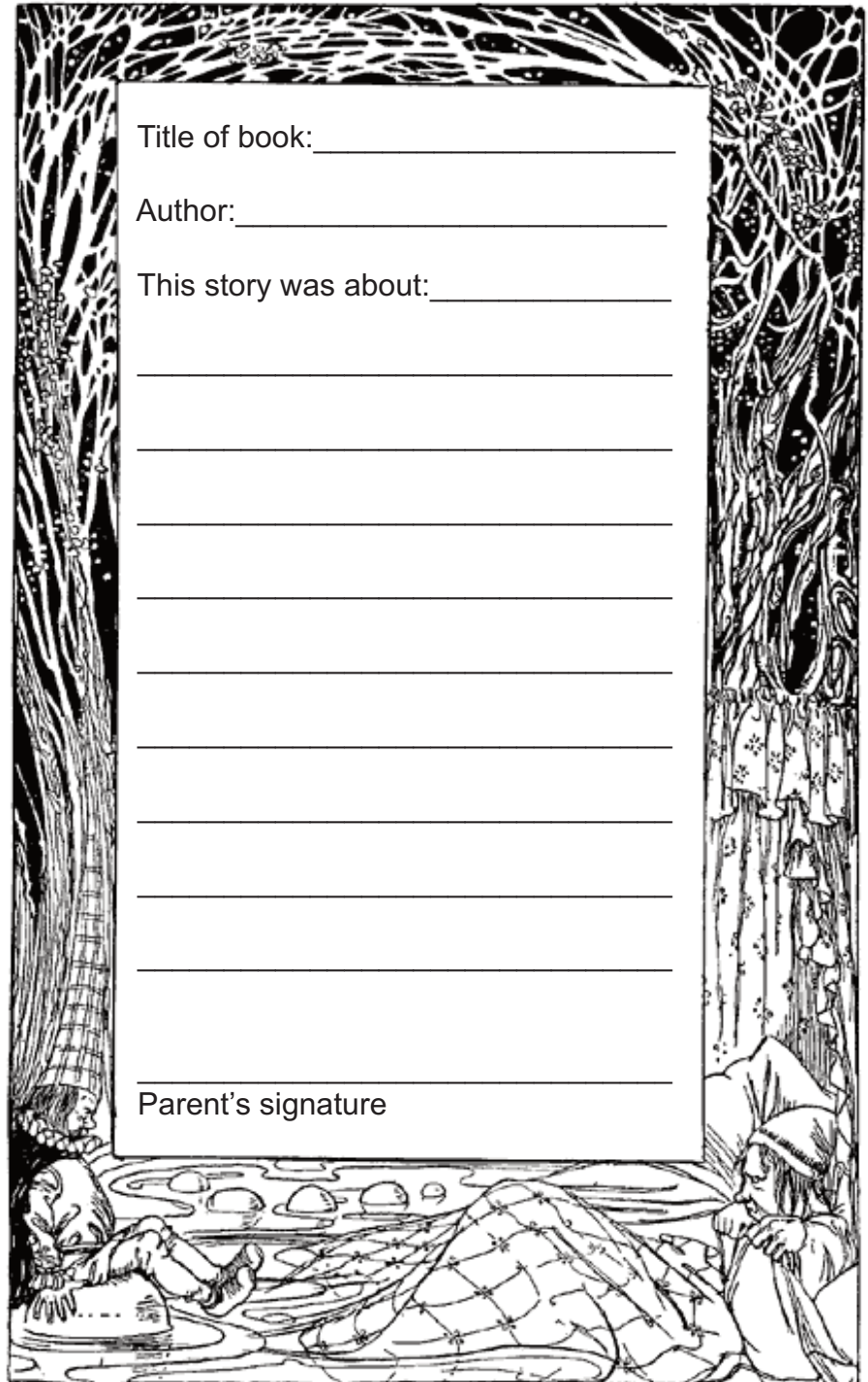

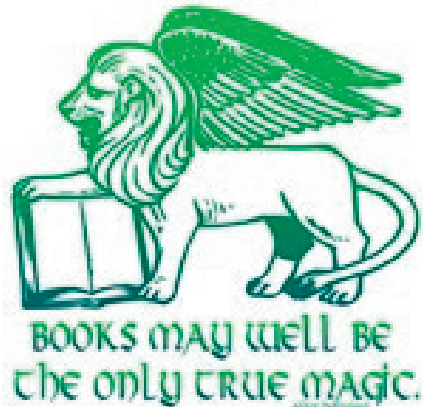
## HEY FAES YELLOWJACKETS!

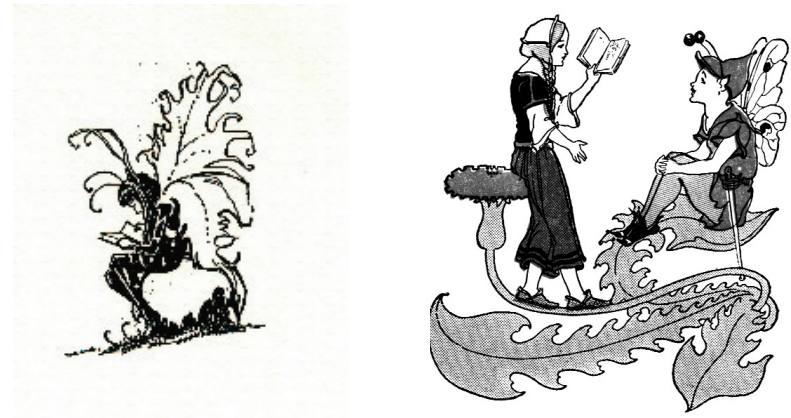
All received booklets will be displayed during the FAES Fall Open House/Book Fair in the Library
