915 Booster Organizations

Purpose

The Board recognizes booster organizations as being formed for the purpose of assisting and supporting extracurricular activities in the schools.

Delegation of Responsibility

The activities of booster organizations will be reviewed by the administration and reported to the Board **as necessary** to ensure that the activities promote student interests primarily, rather than the special interests of any particular group.

Each booster organization will present, in writing, to the building principal a plan for all projects and activities. The building principal will evaluate such plans and make a report to the Superintendent. No project will be initiated without the review of the building principal, and will be subject to the Board's right to reject any proposed project.

The recommendation for each plan submitted will be made on the basis of educational value to the total school program, benefit to students, and compliance with community standards.

Guidelines

Fundraising activities will be governed by the same rules and regulations that govern all other school-related fundraising drives.

District facilities will be used in accordance with the guidelines established in Board policy.[1]

Decisions, such as selection of student participants, coaches and/or advisors, and scheduling, that affect the operation of the group which the booster organization supports will be determined by the school administration and applicable policies adopted by the Board.

The Board retains final authority over all phases of the educational program, including the help of any booster organizations.
