NOTES:

1. Morning buses will run on the regular AM schedule. Students shall report to the auditorium upon arrival until the 7:32AM bell which will indicate that all students need to report to their first exam period classroom.
2. All students that walk or drive to school need to be at school no less than ten (10) minutes prior to the start of an exam. For example, for a student is coming in for the second or third final exam of the day, the student does not need to arrive until 10 minutes prior to their exam ONLY if they are not required to be in all the final exams scheduled for that day.
3. A student who does not report to the examination room by the start time (indicated by the "late" bell) will be refused entrance into the exam room. Since the Final Exam Schedule is being announced weeks in advance, make-up opportunities will only be considered if the student has a legitimate and certified reason for the tardiness or absence (e.g. sudden illness certified by physician, family death certified by parent), and only at the convenience of the testing teacher.
4. Once a student exits the school building (for any reason), the student may not re-enter the building and/or ride the PM bus home. Please make all arrangements for transportation with your parents/guardian well in advance.
5. Students must report to their scheduled class period, even if they do not have a final during the testing sessions for supervision. Students will not be permitted to be in Cafeteria, Auditorium and/or hallway areas during any exam session.
6. Building areas closed during Final Exams Periods: Junior High Gym, Senior High Gym, Library, and Classrooms not in use during the time of the exam (LOCKED).
7. The Cafeteria will offer lunch/snack items to any/all students during the designated break times (8:50-9:10 and 10:25-10:45). Snack purchases are cash only, where one (1) lunch can be purchased using current Free and Reduced system. All food must be consumed in cafeteria - no food or drink bottles may exit the cafeteria. NOTE: Breakfast will NOT be served during the Final Exam days. Please eat breakfast before coming to school.
8. During the Final Examinations window, school is considered to remain in session. Therefore, all school policies and regulations are in effect, inclusive but not limited to **Dress Code guidelines**. Policy violations may revoke the opportunity to participate in final examinations.
9. No electronic devices, including cell phones of any kind, are permitted in a classroom testing area. These devices are to either a) remain at home, b) turned off and placed in their locked locker for the duration of the final examination or c) if a student no longer has a locker, they shall hand over their phone to the testing teacher to hold for the exam period and the phone will be returned to the student at the end of the testing period.
