As part of a comprehensive process of planning for the future, approve the exploration of alternatives to renovating the Junior-Senior High School, including:

- Authorize Administration and Robert T. Scheeran , A.I.A. Architects to conduct a facility study involving renovations/rental costs to house the Junior-Senior High School within the Greater Johnstown Career and Technology Center.
- Authorize exploration of potential cost figures for FASD, associated with a theoretical merger with neighboring districts.
- Authorize exploration of potential cost figures for FASD, associated with a theoretical purchase of vacant school buildings in other districts.
